Dear Church Family,

"Why is he a new person?" Henry is five years old and has just started attending "big church" with his parents. In the service the other day our Chinese pastor, Andy Liu, baptized five people from their congregation. One of them was here visiting her child and grandchildren over the last six months. She flew back to China the day after her baptism! Our Chinese mission is such a special part of our church, reaching this important group. When Andy raised each of these believers from the water, he declared it so simply that it caught Henry's attention: "A new person!"

Andy said that because of Jesus' teaching. In the most famous conversation in the Bible, Jesus told Nicodemus, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again" (John 3:3). Paul echoed that language when he was talking about the change Jesus makes. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come" (2 Corinthians 5:17). Baptists differ from many denominations and groups by practicing "believer's baptism." Instead of baptizing infants into the church family, our understanding is that when someone decides to follow Jesus as Lord, that is when they are born again. Baptism is then a symbol of that change and a step of obedience as follow Christ.

I hope that every one of you is already one of Jesus'"new people." This is the most important decision we make in life. If you need to take that step or follow the example of Jesus in baptism, please contact us! Our staff loves these conversations. I'm also looking forward to having a conversation with Henry a few years down the road to talk a whole lot more about becoming a new person in Christ!

There's a common sign throughout the subway system in London: "Mind the Gap." It's alerting travelers to the space between the platform and the train. Right now we have a gap I want to alert all of us to consider. It's the gap between our budget and our giving this year. For several years we have given above our budget, allowing us to maximize our work in ministry. In addition, since the start of last year, we have given \$2.8 million toward our Hunter Hall/Children's area remodel. However, this year our budget giving is falling significantly behind. If current giving trends continue we would finish the year more than \$300,000 behind budget. We have until June 30 to make up ground for supporting our ministry efforts, continuing to prioritize missions, retain staff, and meet our facilities expenses. Can you help us reduce the gap?
